



## Jacob Majchen

INDIANAPOLIS— Jacob Majchen, age 59, of Indianapolis, passed away Monday, July 29, 2013 at his residence. He was born on June 13, 1954 in Fresno, California as the son of Jake and Dorothy Ann (Pemental) Majchen. He received his Associate Degree from Reedley College in Reedley, California in 2006. He served in the Army during the Post-Vietnam War era, having served from 1975 - 1978. He married Shonna (Young) Majchen on June 17, 1989.

Jacob worked for the IRS for 12 years, was the cook of the Juvenile Detention Center in Tulare, California for several years, worked as the inmate supervisor at the State Prison in Corcoran, California, and most recently worked as the control clerk for the Department of Defense in Indianapolis.
